Pizarro Design Studio (opening spread) can comfortably conjure up both high camp and romantic, understated chic, as evidenced by their two distinct spaces furnished within the Young Hollywood Home. The Levitation Bar (left) is made of wood covered in multiple coats of white automotive lacquer and has a glass counter that rotates a full 360 degrees. The bar comes with a "floating" wood shell unit easily backlit for different mood-setting options. The three LCD/DVD players with 14-inch screens behind the bar are by Toshiba, who furnished electronics throughout the Young Hollywood Home space.
